Why am I seeing a pharmacist?

- Your doctor or other health-care provider has referred you to the pharmacist at the Mount Sinai Academic Family Health Team
- This does not necessarily mean there is a problem with your medications
- The pharmacist will meet with you to make sure that you are receiving the best medications, and to ensure you understand the benefits and risks of your medications
- You can request an appointment for a time that is convenient for you

What will the pharmacist do?

The pharmacist will meet with you in the clinic to:

- ask you questions about all of your medications
- review your chart and explain why you are taking each of your medications, and the side effects you need to watch for
- answer any questions you may have about your medications
- make suggestions to your doctor or other health-care provider
- meet with you in the future to follow up on managing your medications

What should I take with me?

- 1. All of your medications.

 Please bring **ALL** prescription and nonprescription drugs, vitamins, supplements
 and herbal medicines, including all pills,
 medicated creams, patches, sprays,
 inhalers and eye drops.
- 2. A list of questions that you have for the pharmacist.
- 3. A list of your allergies.
