

# Driving Assessment Services Directory

The driving assessment programs below (except St. Joseph's Health Centre) have two components: a clinical evaluation and an on-road evaluation. These programs require referral forms, which can be found on their websites.

**The clinical evaluation** entails an occupational therapist to generally assess the patient's cognitive skills, medical history, and driving history. This commonly takes one and a half hours to two hours.

**The on-road evaluation** will have a certified driving instructor, together with an occupational therapist, assess the patient's physical ability, cognitive/behavioural skills, visual/perceptual skills, and all responses to the traffic environments. This commonly takes one hour.
